

First Prize: Ms. Rani Lonare, Second Year Post B. Sc Nursing


Second Prize: Ms. Rajeshwari Wasnik, Second Year Post B. Sc Nursing

- Reinforced the importance of maintaining a ragging-free campus environment



Ms. Gayatri Barde delivered an informative and impactful session. Her presentation covered:


- Definition and various forms of ragging

Outcome of Programme:



- **Preventive Measures:**




Conclusion:

Overall, the program was highly informative and successful in spreading awareness about the importance of creating a ragging-free campus culture.

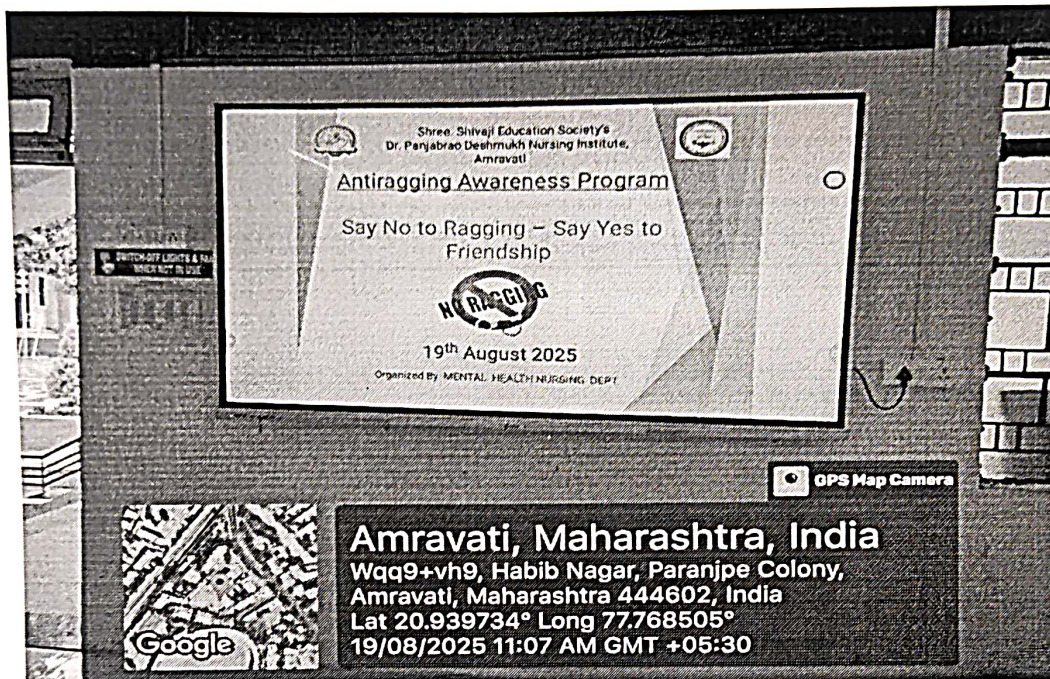

- Ethical and legal awareness among students was significantly strengthened.



First Prize: Ms. Rani Lonare, Second Year Post B. Sc Nursing


