POLICY DOCUMENT ON CAPABILITY ENHANCEMENT SCHEMES

Introduction:

Capability enhancement schemes are programs designed to improve the skills and abilities of individuals, often with a focus on preparing them for employment or enhancing their overall development.

Dr. PDNI Amravati believes in empowering the nursing students by supporting them with needed capability enhancement schemes typically cover a range of areas such as;

- 1. Soft skills development
- 2. Language and communication skill development
- 3. Yoga and wellness
- 4. Analytical skills development
- 5. Human value development
- 6. Personality and professional development
- 7. Employability skills development

Title: This policy shall be called as CAPABILITY ENHANCEMENT SCHEMES.

Implementation: This policy shall come into force with effect from 01/08/2024.

Applicability of the policy: This policy shall be applicable to all the staff and students of Dr. PDNI Amravati.

Rules - Capability enhancement schemes

- 1. The members of student welfare committee (SWC), Dr. PDNI shall implement the capability enhancement schemes.
- 2. The SWC shall coordinate with the staff, students, and other teams / agencies to conduct capability enhancement schemes among students of varied groups.
- 3. The SWC shall enrol the name of students to participate in the capability enhancement schemes.

- 4. The time schedule for the capability enhancement schemes shall be displayed on the web-site and college notice board.
- 5. The target group for capability enhancement schemes is the students of Dr. PDNI Amravati.
- 6. The SWC shall ensure that the students are attending the yoga & wellness sessions regularly.
- 7. At the end of the year, a "certificate of participation" in the capability enhancement scheme shall be issued to the students.
- 8. All departments must emphasize on the implementation of capability enhancement schemes among nursing students.
- 9. The SWC shall maintain the records / reports of capability enhancement schemes for the purpose of documentation.

For easy process of implementation, the above seven schemes shall be divided into three groups; Group A, Group B and Group C.
